



Camberwell Drive – what happened?

- An incident occurred in December 2021, causing a hole to open in the public open space area
- The ground collapse was fenced and infilled with over 300 tons of stone
- The exact cause of the collapse is unknown but was thought to be linked to the recorded mine shaft
- We have continued to monitor the site and the surrounding road – this has shown no further movement
- Site has been maintained whilst we have looked into options

Approximate Position of Ground Collapse


Temporary car park area




Plan of the temporary car park

- Newsletter to wider community and those unable to attend tonight
 - Completed with additional updates on the website
- Hold discussions with immediately impacted residents
 - Ongoing with productive discussions already held
- Finalise the design proposals
 - Currently being undertaken additional investigation to finalise
- Liaise with Tameside Council to understand prior approvals required
 - Being progressed for the car park construction and ongoing
- Liaise with utility companies
 - Commenced and ongoing
- We listened to feedback about the footway to the south of Camberwell Drive and have confirmed with our consultants that this will remain open

- Complete the temporary car park
- Undertake additional ground investigation
- Appoint community liaison officer
- Undertake pre-commencement surveys for immediately affected residents, these will be arranged on a personal basis and will be undertaken prior to the investigation and main drilling works
