During the development of the detailed design and planning application, some of the key factors that will be considered include:

- Construction traffic movements.
- Suitability of the access track and bridge for construction traffic.
- Noise and vibration.
- Dust and odour management.
- Surface water management.
- Waste management.
- Power and water supply.
- Visual impact of the scheme.
- Impact on historical heritage and ecological features.
- How the scheme will be operated to clean up pollution and prevent any nuisance.

These factors will be considered as part of the detailed design and suitable measures to minimise their impact on residents and businesses will be addressed as part of the planning process.
